

Historic Resources Board Meeting

- I. Call to Order (2:01PM)
Present: Henry Lussy (Chair), Mary Lynn McKenna (Vice-Chair), Bob Wren, and Gayla Hess (HPO).

HPO briefed the HRB on Commission approval for the Lakota Group proposal and contract award, reported that Project Manager Vauthier expects to see a contract soon and that letters to all firms will go out this week.
