BOARD OF HEALTH MEETING MINUTES

Thursday, June 27, 2019 Anaconda Community Center, 3rd floor

1. Meeting called to order--Karan Kunz, board chair, called the meeting to order at 5:07pm
2. Public Comment for agenda items--No public comment
3. Full quorum at present at 5:20pm, proceeded with Board of Health business
 - A. Approval of minutes from May 23rd meeting. Motion made by Angie Galetti to adopt minutes with edits, seconded by Audrey Mattson
 - B. Board voted on appointing Dr Reiter to role of Medical Officer. Nilda moved for appointment, Audrey seconded, and board approved appointment unanimously.
 - C. Discussion on appointing board secretary.--No volunteers for position, board chose to move forward with members rotating responsibility of recording minutes for the time being.
 - D. Discussion of Board of Health column in Anaconda Leader.--ThePublic Health has regular columns in local paper. This has been handled by Public Health Director until recently. Karan Kunz requested that each member of the board supply a short bio to include in column to introduce board members to public and increase awareness and approachability for public.
4. Public Health Department Update
 - a. See attached report. Discussion included the demand on current Public Health staff in trying to meet the needs of the public and current grants

with Director on extended leave, and minimal certified staff in the office. Of particular concern is the lack of a certified Car Seat Technician: there is currently no one in the county to meet the need, and training is a full week, making it fiscally unrealistic for any department to currently get any staff certified.

5. Sanitarian Update

- a. See attached report. Discussion included apparent resolution of bed bug problem at local motel. Motel was treated, and the county has not received any further reports since treatment.
