 - a. Address concerns of complaint filed by Rose Nyman –
 - i. Rose reported that she thought that some mature trees through the downtown are nuisance trees that leave purple berries on the sidewalks and the birds carry these to other trees. She mentioned that some have had the branches too low to walk under but she feels those might have been addressed. Lydia explained that when the trees are purchased by the adjacent property owners as part of the project, a "Care Agreement" [sample attached] is signed stating that the purchaser agrees to water the trees and arrange for pruning of the trees as needed. Further discussion on a resolution. It was suggested that as the downtown trees get replaced that the tree committee will not plant ornamental cherry trees in our urban setting. Discussion.
- VI. Public Comment- Rose Nyman brought up the numerous dead and diseased trees throughout the community. It was reported that if the ADLC tree board applies for and receives a DNRC [Department of Natural Resources and Conservation] grant this year, the funds could be used to replace the trees that were lost because of a deep frost in October that happened before the trees could harden off.
