

SafeCare Augmented

SafeCare Augmented features weekly home visits, over four to six months, for families with children ages 0 to 5. The program is available in Butte-Silver Bow and Anaconda-Deer Lodge.

• SafeCare focuses on four areas:

- health, home safety, interactions between parents and children, and problem-solving and communication.

• Home visitors (Family Development Specialists) observe parental

knowledge and skills, describe and explain the rationale for a desired behavior, demonstrate the desired behavior, and ask the parent to practice the desired interaction. The Family Development Specialist then provides feedback.

Nurse-Family Partnership

Services provided by:

- Butte-Silver Bow Health Department

The Nurse-Family Partnership partners first-time moms with a nurse home visitor. The program is available in

Butte-Silver Bow.

• A Registered Nurse visits the mother in

the home throughout the pregnancy until the baby turns 2 years old.

• The program offers flexibility in

visiting schedules, times

and locations.

• Qualifications: Client is a first-time

mother, meets low-income criteria,

participates voluntarily, and is

enrolled and receives her first

home visit by no later than 28 weeks

of pregnancy.

for success in school and in life.

opportunities to succeed, regardless of any

demographic, geographic or economic

considerations.
